Day Shift (7:00am – 3:00pm)

Every 2 hours starting after students arrive (8:15am) 2 custodial workers

High Touched Surface Areas – door knobs, push bars, drinking fountains, soap dispensers, and handles cleaned/sanitized with EnvirOx H₂ Orange₂ Hyper Concentrate 112 (Orange oil and hydrogen peroxide based cleaner)

Lunch Periods (10:40am – 1:30pm) (1-2 custodial workers)

After students eat lunch in classrooms and are at recess – clean/sanitize desks, chairs, high touch areas, and damp mop floor with EnvirOx H₂ Orange₂ Hyper Concentrate 112 in each classroom.

Night Shift (3:00pm – 11:00pm) 2 Custodial Workers
